Concertgebouw - Concertgebouwplein 2-6

Monday 4 June - 20:00-21:40

Het Concertgebouw, “...the best instrument in the orchestra it houses...” (quoting Bernard Haitink), the world famous neoclassical building best known for its superior acoustics, will host the congress concert specially performed by the *Netherlands Chamber Orchestra*.

The “*Concertgebouw*” is located in Amsterdam “*Oud-Zuid*” (Old South) near the “*Rijksmuseum*”. When visiting the ‘*Concertgebouw*’, just realise that when architect Adolf Leonard van Gendt started building in 1883, it was located outside the Amsterdam-city boundaries in an empty polder.

While attending the concert, enjoy the neoclassic splendour of the Main Hall and notice that you are surrounded by the names of composers famous and admired at the time the building was constructed.

The *Netherlands Chamber Orchestra* is a separate entity within the Netherlands Philharmonic Orchestra Amsterdam. Founded in 1955 this ensemble, now led by the violinist Gordan Nikolic, has been among the top of the specialised chamber orchestras for many years. Especially their Bach interpretations set a standard for years to come.

Entrance to the concert will be limited to congress participants (Full Registration and Accompanying registration). The provisional ticket included in the badge **must be turned into the final seating ticket** at the “**Social Events desk**” within **Monday 4 June at 16:30**. *Hostesses are not allowed to admit to those people without a seating ticket*. A coffee service will be provided during the intermission.

Admission to the concert is not possible after the beginning of the performance.
